### Getting Dressed

Safety is our primary concern. We offer many different styles of equipment to suit your needs.

Jacks/Pants are available for those who only need covering on half of their bodies.



Coveralls are available for those who want their entire body covered.



The clothing is to protect your own clothing. They are not sufficient protection from blunt blows or scraping. Please follow our safety rules while inside the smash room. While we do try to offer

various sizes, we apologize that we can only carry so many. Children who are under 5 feet may need to wear their own protective clothing. We offer plus sizes up to 2XL.

### **Choosing the Right Mask**
